Venue Details

AUDITORIUM

- Enjoy our superbly acoustic Auditorium with projection screen capabilities. Perfect for an intimate concert, film screening, lecture, or presentation.
- Raised stage with vaulted proscenium; 142 fixed seats plus wheelchair spaces.
- Grand piano available (additional rental fee required)
- A/V capabilities include remote links and multiple mics for panel discussions and audience interaction.
- Beverages allowed in this space, but no food.
- The Parlor/Café/Courtyard may be rented for a reception add on.

MARIPILI AT CAFÉ FRIEDA

- Have a rare dining experience with Galician focused cuisine prepared by award winning Chef Grayson Corrales.
- Equally suited to a formal seated meal as to a casual cocktail reception.
- Gracious views of the museum exteriors and reflecting pool.
- Dining capacity- 60, Reception capacity- 85.
- Add the Frye Parlor and Courtyard for a combined standing reception capacity of 160.

COURTYARD

- Take your party outside to our beautiful, open-air Moss Dome Courtyard and listen to the sounds of the cathedral bells and birds as they mix with the city soundscape.
- Dining capacity 35, Reception capacity 65.
- Seasonal use only (and weather dependent).

ART STUDIO

- Host a team building retreat, writer's workshop, or have one of our teaching artists lead an art making class for your group! Teaching artist fee not included in space rental fee.
- Our Art Studio boasts an industrial chic feel with vaulted ceilings, skylights, and incredible natural light.
- Seated capacity 50, Reception capacity 75.
- Facilities include a sink and small prep counter.

- Access to all available art supplies for team-building activities etc., if desired.
- Food and beverage allowed in this space.

FRYE PARLOR

- Frye Parlor is a space for connection that's part lounge, part experimental installation. This artist-designed (by artist Jayme Yen) social hub invites you to relax, recharge, and engage in a setting that blurs the boundaries between art and experience.
- Extending beyond the museum's formal galleries, Frye Parlor spans the common areas linking the auditorium, café, and art studio. Add this space onto your café, auditorium, or Courtyard rental, for more space for your guests.
- Food and beverage allowed in this space.
- Modular soft seating installed, bistros upon request.

MUSEUM GALLERIES

- Make the party more arty! Upgrade your access to include the entire museum, which can increase your guest capacity beyond reception restrictions.
- Give guests the opportunity to stroll the exhibition galleries privately, outside of public hours.
- Exhibitions on view are dependent on what shows are current in the museum.
- However, Frye Salon is always on view! The Salon features over one hundred paintings from the Frye Art Museum's Founding Collection hung floor to ceiling— salon style. The installation approximates the dramatic viewing experience enjoyed by visitors to Charles and Emma Frye's Seattle home in the first decades of the twentieth century.
- No food or beverage allowed in the galleries.



RENTAL FEES & POLICIES

Each event rental (4) hours which includes setup and cleanup.

Food and beverage is NOT included in space rental fees. MariPili food & beverage packages available as additional add-ons. Outside catering is also permitted. Please note that outside vendor

If your event happens during Frye open hours (Wed, Fri, Sat, Sun 11am-5pm, Thursday 11am-8pm), you and your guests will have access to the galleries. However, if this is an after-hours or closed day event (Mon & Tues), you and your guests will not have access to roam the galleries, only your rental areas – unless you have opted for a full buyout, in which you'll have access to the entire museum.

MariPili at Cafe Frieda: \$2,500 - (please note that food and beverage is a separate cost, and to be negotiated with MariPili, or an outside caterer)

Auditorium: \$2,500

Art Studio: \$2,000

Courtyard: \$1,500 - (seasonal and weather dependent. Can be rented separately or as an add-on to the auditorium and/or the café)

Frye Parlor: \$1,500 - (Can be rented separately or as an add-on to your Auditorium, Café, and/or Courtyard rental)

Full Museum buyout: \$10,000

Registered 501(c)3 non-profit discount: 10%

Rental Policies:

- Prices are subject to change based on whether the museum is open to the public or closed to the public "after hours".
- The Frye is closed to the public on Mondays and Tuesdays. Because of this, only full buyouts will be permitted on those days.
- As a standard policy, we will require 30 days' notice to plan any rental event, with or without food & beverage.
