### **AVAILABLE SPACE DETAILS**

#### **AUDITORIUM**

- Superb acoustics with projection screen capabilities; perfect for an intimate concert, film screening, lecture, or presentation.
- Raised stage with vaulted proscenium; 142 fixed seats plus wheelchair spaces.
- Grand piano available (*additional rental fee required*)
- A/V capabilities include remote links and multiple mics for panel discussions and audience interaction.
- Beverages are allowed in this space, but food is not permitted.
- The Frye Parlor/Café/Courtyard may be rented for a reception add-on.

#### **MARIPILI AT CAFÉ FRIEDA**

- Host a rare dining experience with Galician-inspired cuisine prepared by award-winning Chef Grayson Corrales.
- The Café can accommodate a formal seated meal or casual cocktail reception.
- Gracious views of the museum exteriors and reflecting pool.
- Dining capacity: 60; reception capacity: 85
- Add the Frye Parlor and Courtyard for a combined standing reception capacity of 160.

#### **COURTYARD**

- Take your party outside to our beautiful, open-air Courtyard and listen to the sounds of the cathedral bells and birds as they mix with the city soundscape.
- Dining capacity: 35; reception capacity: 65
- *Seasonal use only (and weather dependent)*

### **Frye STUDIO**

- Host a team building retreat, writers' workshop, or have one of our teaching artists lead an art-making class for your group! Please note, the *teaching artist fee is not included in the space rental fee.*
- The Frye Studio boasts an industrial chic feel with vaulted ceilings, skylights, and incredible natural light.
- Seated capacity: 50; reception capacity: 75
- Facilities include a sink and a small prep counter.
- Access to all available art supplies for team-building activities, etc., if desired.
- *Food and beverages are allowed in this space.*

### **FRYE PARLOR**

- Frye Parlor is a space for connection that's part lounge, part experimental installation. This artist-designed social hub invites you to relax, recharge, and engage in a setting that blurs the boundaries between art and experience.
- Located beyond the museum's galleries, Frye Parlor extends to the Auditorium, Café, and Frye Studio. Add this space to your rental to accommodate more guests. *Food and beverages are allowed in this space.*
- Modular soft seating installed; bistros upon request.

### **MUSEUM GALLERIES**

- Make the party more arty! Upgrade your access to include the entire museum, which can increase your guest capacity beyond reception restrictions.
- Give guests the opportunity to stroll through the exhibition galleries privately, outside of public hours.
- *Please note, our exhibitions rotate throughout the year, and the artwork on view will change with each new season of shows.*
- *The Salon* features over one hundred paintings from the Frye Art Museum's *Founding Collection* hung floor to ceiling—salon style. The installation approximates the dramatic viewing experience enjoyed by visitors to Charles and Emma Frye's Seattle home in the first decades of the twentieth century.
- *No food or beverages are allowed in the galleries.*

### **RENTAL POLICIES**

- Each event rental is four hours and includes setup and cleanup. Extra time may be added to your event rental for an extra fee per hour.
- NO rentals during museum public hours. The museum is open to the public Wednesday–Sunday 11 am–5 pm and Thursday 11 am–8 pm.
- NO ceremonies, weddings, events, parties, etc. are permitted in Frye Salon, or any of the other galleries at the Frye.
- NO flash photography, fresh flowers, or real candles are allowed in the museum.
- Food and beverages are only allowed in certain areas of the museum including the Frye Studio, Cafe, Frye Parlor, and Courtyard.
- As a standard policy, we require at least 30 days' notice to plan any rental event.
- *Food and beverages are NOT included in space rental fees. MariPili food & beverage packages available as additional add-ons. MariPili has first rights of refusal for catering any rental event. If MariPili is unable to cater the event, outside catering is also permitted. Please note that outside vendors are subject to approval by the Frye Special Events Coordinator.*
- Access to the galleries is NOT included in your rental, unless opting for a full buyout.
- You and your guests only have access to your rental areas, i.e. Auditorium, Café, and Frye Parlor. If you have opted for a full buyout you and your guests will have access to the entire museum, including the galleries.

### **RENTAL FEES**

#### **MariPili at Café Frieda: \$2,500**

*(please note that food and beverages are a separate cost, and to be negotiated with MariPili, or an outside caterer if MariPili is unable to cater your event)*

**Auditorium: \$2,500**

**Frye Studio: \$2,000**

**Courtyard: \$1,500**

*(Open air and weather dependent. Can be rented separately or as an add-on to the Auditorium and/or the Café)*
